This year also we have achieved 100% result. Out of 33 students 29 students scored distinction.

Highest score is 94.8%. It was a great achievement.

Training for teachers

Two days of English language skill development programs for all teachers was conducted on 6th and 7th May. Resource person was Dr. Sheena George, Principal of St. Pauls Public school.

Teachers have participated in Capacity Building programme organised by CBSE on various topics and also subject wise Sahodaya training program and have received certificates.

School reopened for std.1-10 on June 3rd. Std.1 students were marched with flowers to public school.

School diary was distributed on 13th June.

Eco club

Environment day is celebrated on June 5th. As part of it students brought traditional toys or crafts using eco- friendly materials and posters were also displayed.

On 16 th November, 10 students from our school participated in **Haritha Sabha** at NSLP school which was organized as a part of Malinya Mukta Navakerala Janakiya camp under Pattanakkad block panchayat with the aim of ensuring participation of children in the field of waste management. Students won certificates for their active participation.

Students cultivated vegetables in the school premises and shared it among the needy.

Oru Pidi Nanma is a programme organised by the district collector of Alappuzha to help poor people and students of our school contributed various household things and it is handed over to the concerned authorities.

Health

On 14th June as part of anti rabies awareness programme a pledge was taken by students and teachers.

The department of health conducted health screening for the students of class 2nd to 10th they visited twice in a month and checked eyesight, height and weight. Details of each student is recorded in our School health report.

Iron tablets were also distributed to students of class 6 to 10 every week for three months. Deworming tablets were distributed to the students.

On 21st November, Our health department administered an oath to our students to take in the Assembly which aims to raise awareness about the importance of maintaining good health and hygiene practices.

Reading day was celebrated on 19th June. As part of it aksharaslogam was conducted by students and a poem was also recited.

As part of **Arts fest** offstage competitions started on 19th June.

On 26th June, arts fest and Arts club was inaugurated by our Manager Rev. Dr. Grimbald Lanthaparambil.

Community service programme

On 21st June, as part of celebration of white cane day, the Indian association for the blind have handed flag stamps which cost ₹10 to support education and rehabilitation of visually challenged individuals and our students contributed an amount towards this cause.

As per CBSE rules, **SAFAL exam** started in our school on 22nd July till 6th August for the students of class 6th and 9th.

As a part of 4th anniversary of NEP, CBSE has organised '**Shiksha Saptah**'. from 22nd July to 28th July and students of our school participated in various activities and uploaded to CBSE.

Independence day was celebrated on 15th August and the chief guest was Fr. Joseph Naduvilaparambil and our Manager Rev. Dr. Grimbald Lanthaparambil hoisted the flag.

The events started with march past followed by many entertainment programs. On 22nd August **Maths exhibition** was conducted by our maths club. Students enthusiastically participated in it and made wonderful and amazing models on various topics.

On 5th September **Teachers day** was celebrated. Students presented flowers to their teachers followed by a group photo session. A speech was also given by Ms. Anila.

Alappuzha Sahodaya Kalotsav was conducted at St. Aloysius Senior Secondary School Punnapura on October 18,19,23,24 and 25. 28 students of our school participated in various events. **Neelima B Nair of Std. IX got 1st prize in Mappilappattu and Neha Vimal got first prize in collage making.**

Four students from our school participated in **Muditha** an Inter School gathering, hosted by Sacred Heart CMI Public School, Thevara on 28th September and **Neerav of Class .II C got fifth position in clay modeling.**
